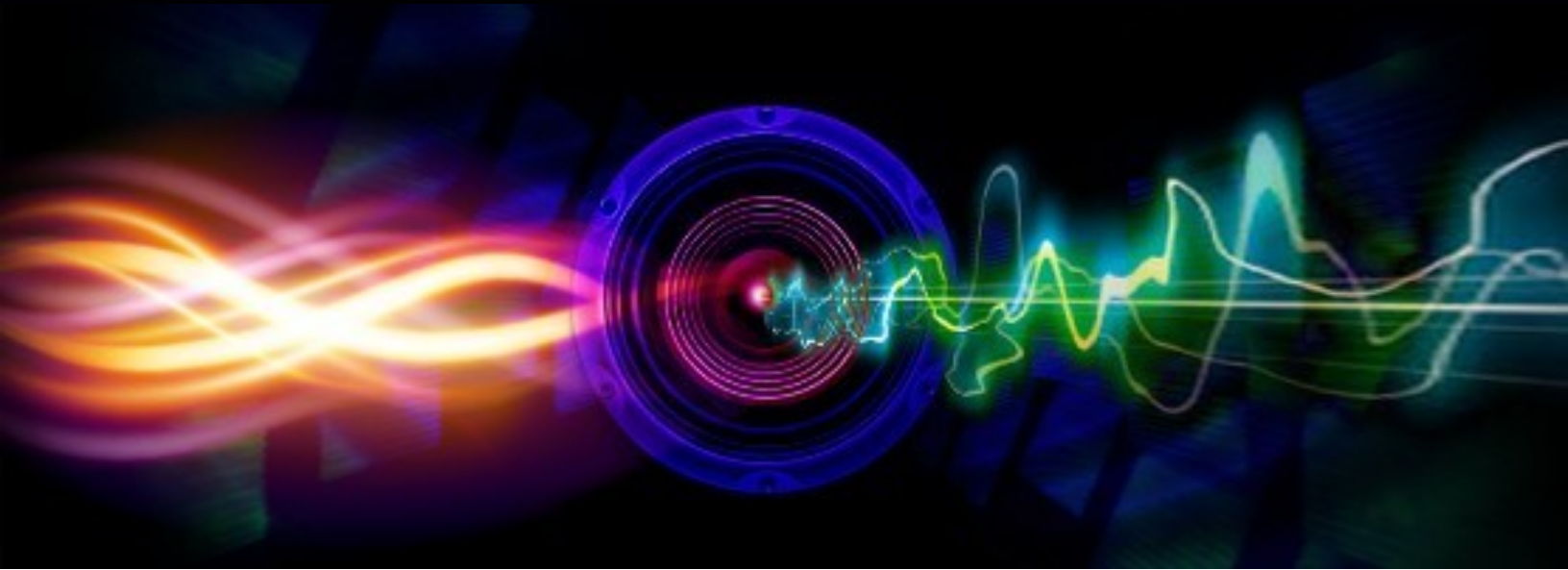


Sonic Literacies

Barring hearing loss, we live immersed in sounds. From the music playing on our stereos and iPods to the rustle of the wind through the trees, from the voices of people talking, laughing, coughing to the whirr of the electronic devices—we cannot get away from sound. Even in silence, which does not ever truly exist, we hear the sound of our breath and the blood going through our veins. (McKee, 2006)
